How to Forward Questions to TSSA Storm Safe regarding Glazed Systems suspected of having Wind related Issues

Attn: Public Adjusters

TSSA Storm Safe is your tool to help properly assess whether or not a Glazing Assessment is necessary. If you are inspecting a claim, and you have a question if the windows / Sliders should be included in the scope, then follow these simple guidelines, to forward a request via email for an electronic assessment of the conditions of the glazings on your project. Be sure to include the project name / location, as well as the adjusters contact information.

Please take pictures of the following points of the windows as diagramed in the sketch on Page 2

- 1- Clear overall shot of window system
- 2- Both Jam (Side) of window including Dry Wall
- 3- Header & Footer of Window including Drywall & Sill
- 4- Picture of Meeting Rail
- 5- Any Screws from Frame on all sides
- 6- Outside picture of Masonry (if possible)

Please make sure all photos are clear with large pixilation.

These are just a small sampling of photos necessary for us to minimally access the condition of the window, but it should be adequate to ascertain if the next step should be addressed. The goal is to make sure that all the damage on your scope is defendable and can be substantiated.
